Notice to Skippers No. 28/2021

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1 point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (consolidated text: Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2021, item 624) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (consolidated text Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568, as amended), Polish Waters State Water Holding, Regional Water Management Board in Białystok informs that:

from 18 to 29 September 2021, exercises of the First Warsaw Armoured Brigade subunits will take place in Nowogród, at the section of the Narew River waterway at km 181+800 – 182+000.

In view of the above, between **18 and 27 September 2021**, the navigation waterway on the aforementioned section will be temporarily closed (for periods of about 1 hour) to secure the military training in overcoming water obstacles. The temporary closure of the waterway will take place upstream and downstream using belaying boats.

At the same time, **on 28 and 29 September 2021, the Narew River waterway at km 181+800 – 182+000 will be closed for navigation due** to practical military exercises in overcoming water obstacles.

It is recommended to exercise extreme caution and unconditionally obey the navigational signs posted.
