### Navigation Message No. 7/2021

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1 point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 Water Law (consolidated text: Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2021 item 624) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (consolidated text: Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2019 item 1568 as amended), the State Water Holding "Polish Waters" – Regional Water Management Board in Białystok announces that:

**since 28 April 2021, the waterway of the Narew river is going to be open from 83+500 km to 248+500 km, i.e. from the mouth of the Orzyc River to the mouth of the Biebrza River.**

The waterway is going to be opened at the minimum depth for safe navigation of 115 cm, with the water level at the Ostrołęka water gauge of 136 cm.

#### Navigational difficulties:

144+750 km (railway bridge in Grabowo) – free passage of vessels possible only between 7:00 and 8:00 a.m due to construction works. The scheduled completion date: 9 May 2021.

Crossing the area of the bridge under repair requires extreme caution.
