Notice to Skippers No. 14/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1 point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 Water Law (consolidated text: Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2021, item 624) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (consolidated text Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568, as amended), the "Polish Waters" State Water Holding – Regional Water Management Board in Białystok hereby informs that:

as of 1 July 2022, the Augustów Canal waterway from the Sosnówek sluice (km 70+300) to the Kudrynki sluice (km 77+400) will be open for navigation.

Navigation is allowed at the following minimum waterway depths:

Waterway section	Kilometre [km]	Waterway depth [cm]
SW Sosnówek – SW Tartak	70+300 - 74+400	90
SW Tartak — SW Kudrynki	74+400 - 77+400	120

Operation time of navigation locks:

Lock	Kilometre [km]	Operation time
Tartak	70+300	10.00 a.m. - 6.00 p.m.
Kudrynki	77+400	10.00 a.m. - 6.00 p.m.

ATTENTION! The last locking starts 30 minutes before closing the lock.

At the same time, the Kurzyniec sluice remains closed. We would like to remind you that according to Regulation No. 3/2022 of the Governor of the Podlaskie Voivodeship dated 15 June 2022, a ban has been introduced on staying within 200 m from the state border with the Republic of Belarus from 1 July 2022 to 15 September 2022.
