Notice to Skippers No. 15/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of 20 July 2017, – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal Of Laws/ of 2021, item 624) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568, as amended), the "Polish Waters" State Water Holding – Regional Water Management Board in Białystok hereby informs that:

in accordance with the permission of the Director of the Office of Inland Navigation in Bydgoszcz of 5 April 2022 no. Gż.426.3.2022, on 8 - 10 July 2022 the "Necko Endurance 2022" 17th Motorboat World Championship will be held on the Necko lake.

Therefore, the following changes will take place on Necko lake:

- by 11 July this year, the navigation route marked by gree
 n and red buoys will be shifted;
- part of the reservoir will be closed for navigation and marked with yellow buoys.

Furthermore, the organiser will provide safety boats marked with red flags, whose crews will spread information that entering the closed area is prohibited.

It is recommended to exercise particular caution on Necko lake, pay attention to the markings, as well as to follow the announcements and information provided by the organiser.
