Notice to Skippers No. 28/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of 20 July 2017 Water Law (consolidated text: Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2021, item 2233, as amended) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (consolidated text Dz.U./Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 1863, as amended), the "Polish Waters" State Water Holding – Regional Water Management Board in Białystok hereby informs that:

starting from 5 October 2022, the Karwik lock and weir at the Jegliński Canal (6+000 km mark of the Pisz-Węgorzewo main navigation waterway in the Great Masurian Lakes System) will be undergoing renovation.

The lock will be out of service until the end of October 2023.

We ask all users of the Great Masurian Lakes System waterways to take the above into account when preparing their navigation plans. The exact date for the re-opening of the lock will be announced via a separate Notice to Skippers.
