

Notice to Skippers No. 32/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1(4) of the Act of 20 July 2017, – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2021, item 624) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568, as amended), the "Polish Waters" State Water Holding – Regional Water Management Board in Białystok hereby informs that:

the reduction of navigational markings for the winter season 2022/2023 has been completed on the following waterways:

- on the Narew River from 83+500 km to 248+500 km,
- on the waterways of the Great Masurian Lakes system: the main waterway from the Roś Lake in Pisz
 - to the Angrapa River in Węgorzewo and side waterways,
- on the Augustów Canal.

At the same time, we would like to inform you that as of 24 November 2022, the Augustów Canal

waterway from km 0+000 to km 83+400 will be closed for navigation due to the occurrence of ice phenomena.

Navigation on the other listed waterways is only permitted until ice phenomena occur, subject to familiarity with the local navigational conditions and exercising extreme caution.
